WELCOME

ADVENT CANDLE LIGHTING

Reader 1: Today is the second Sunday of Advent. In Advent we await with eager expectation, the coming of God's promised Messiah. We remember how God came to us in the person of Jesus, how divine Love came down and walked among us as Emmanuel – God with us. We wait with longing for the day when Christ will come once again, and darkness will be no more.

Congregation: "Merciful God, give us grace to heed the warnings of the prophets and forsake our sins, so that we may greet with joy the coming of Jesus Christ our Redeemer."

Reader 2: A reading from the prophet Malachi: "See, I am sending my messenger to prepare the way before me, and the Lord whom you seek will suddenly come to his temple. The messenger of the covenant in whom you delight—indeed, he is coming, says the Lord of hosts."

Reader 1: We continue to wait for the coming of Jesus. Last Sunday, we began in the dark, and lit one candle: the candle of Hope. Today we light the second candle: the candle of Peace.

Reader 2: We light it knowing full well that peace is elusive, and in some parts of the world, it is almost completely absent. Yet in this season of Advent, we trust that God is never absent from us.

Congregation: And even where there is war and discord, whether between countries, within families, or within our own hearts, God is present, leading us in hope and offering us His peace.

CALL TO WORSHIP (Isaiah 11:1-4)

ALL: The Spirit of the LORD will rest on him—the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of might, the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the LORD—

ALL: But with righteousness he will judge the needy, with justice he will give decisions for the poor of the earth.
